Ribat da Arrifana

„Must see“

Ancient Arab settlement, now ruins

Magnificent view

Walking distance from Villa atlantico 15 min

Ideal for a „Sundowner“



It was constructed around 1130, probably by the Sufi and Mahdi master of Christian origin, Abu-l-Qasim Ahmad ibn al-Husayn ibn Qasi, one of the leading political and religious figures in al-Andalus, the Muslim territory that covered most of Iberia during the Islamic Golden Age. Between 1130 and 1140 Ibn Qasi wrote his main work, *The Removal of the Sandals*, which was inspired by both the Old Testament and the Quran. In 1151 he was assassinated in Silves after being accused of betraying Islam by the followers of Abd al-Mu'min and Ibn Almúndir. After this the Ribat of Arrifana was abandoned, with the English crusader and chronicler, Roger of Hoveden, reporting forty years later that it was “recognizable but in ruins”. It is believed that the minaret was used as a watchtower in the fourteenth century. Despite appearing in written records dating back to 1786 and being clearly identifiable as a former inhabited area as late as 1841,[1] the location of the ribat was only identified by archaeologists at the beginning of this millennium. Its architectural features are inspired by the ribats identified in North Africa (Wikipedia).



Sagres

Cabo de São Vicente „Must see“

Location west of the village at the end of the N 268.

The Cape is the southwesternmost point of mainland Europe. Here stands a 62 meter high lighthouse from 1846 and a former monastery, which now houses a small museum dedicated to seafaring (Museu dos Faróis, Tue – Sun 10.00 – 18.00, admission 3 €). Unfortunately, you can not go directly to the western tip, as built or blocked). To the northeast, however, you have a beautiful view of the cliffs and the blazing waves. With good footwear you can (in front of the entrance on the right hand) out onto the cliffs. In the parking lot at the Cape there are numerous food and souvenir stands.

Among other things, the famous "last bratwurst before America" Nice Cafe at the lighthouse.



Fortaleza de Sagres

Location: south of the village on Rua da Fortaleza.

Fortress on the 300-metre-wide rocky peninsula of Ponta de Sagres, which extends one kilometer into the sea. According to legend, the seafaring school of Henry the Navigator was located here (in fact, it was probably more in Lagos). The original fortification was destroyed in 1587 during the attack of Francis Drake and the earthquake of 1755, the current fortress wall dates back to 1793. Otherwise, there are only a few old buildings worth seeing, such as the small church Igreja da Nossa Senhora da Graça from the 16th century with a golden wooden altar. The ruins of many other buildings from the 17th and 18th centuries were unfortunately removed in the 1960s. In 1921, directly behind the entrance, a wind rose (rosa dos ventos) with a diameter of 43 meters, possibly dating back to the times of Henry the Navigator, was discovered, which could have served as navigational calculations at that time. A visit to the complex is especially worthwhile for the beautiful hike along the cliffs.



Odeceixe Windmill

Moinho De Odeceixe

Adress: R. dos Moínhos 14, 8670-320 Odeceixe

This charming, typically-Mediterranean windmill dates from 1898. Built in masonry and wood, it remains in working order and it's possible to see the process of corn and wheat milling. It's Odeceixe's main landmark, and you can see much of the village from the terrace around it.



Vila nova de Milfontes

Pretty small town at the mouth of the Rio Mira. Very nice old town worth seeing, still many small shops for daily needs. No big supermarket.

Among the buildings worth seeing in the historic old town are the fort, which was built between 1599 and 1602 to defend against pirate attacks, the parish church and the lighthouse at Cape Sardão, which dates back to the beginning of the 20th century.



At the estuary of the Rio Mira is a beautiful large sandy beach. In the absence of swell, water sports of any kind are possible here. Rental of kayaks and standup paddleboards.



Idyllic small fishing port in the north of the city. There is also a restaurant with a wonderful view of the Atlantic coast.

Follow the road in front of the villa westward, at the roundabout on the end continue straight ahead onto unpaved road. This follow straight ahead till the end.

Monte Clerigo

At Ribat da Arrifana turn right, follow the marked path. Always along the coast to a parking lot, there straight ahead to Monte Clerigo.

From the villa about 1 h

Note: there is a shortcut through the bushes at the beginning of the unpaved road (on the right).



Praia do Coelha

On the path to Monte Clerigo (see above) in the last quarter larger sand dune, here to the left down the sand path.

Roundtrip Praia do Coelha at low tide

From Praia do Coelha around the rocks to Praia Monte Clerigo.

Difficult hike, can get dangerous!

Only possible at low tide! Have a look at the tides on the Internet. Passing the rocks must be at lowest tide. Nevertheless, you will get wet. Take a waterproof backpack with changing clothes. Stow money, credit cards and cell phone waterproof.

Wear shoes with good grip on wet underground.

Finally through two Barrancos. In the last Barranco small stream crossing. Thereafter follow the paved road upward.

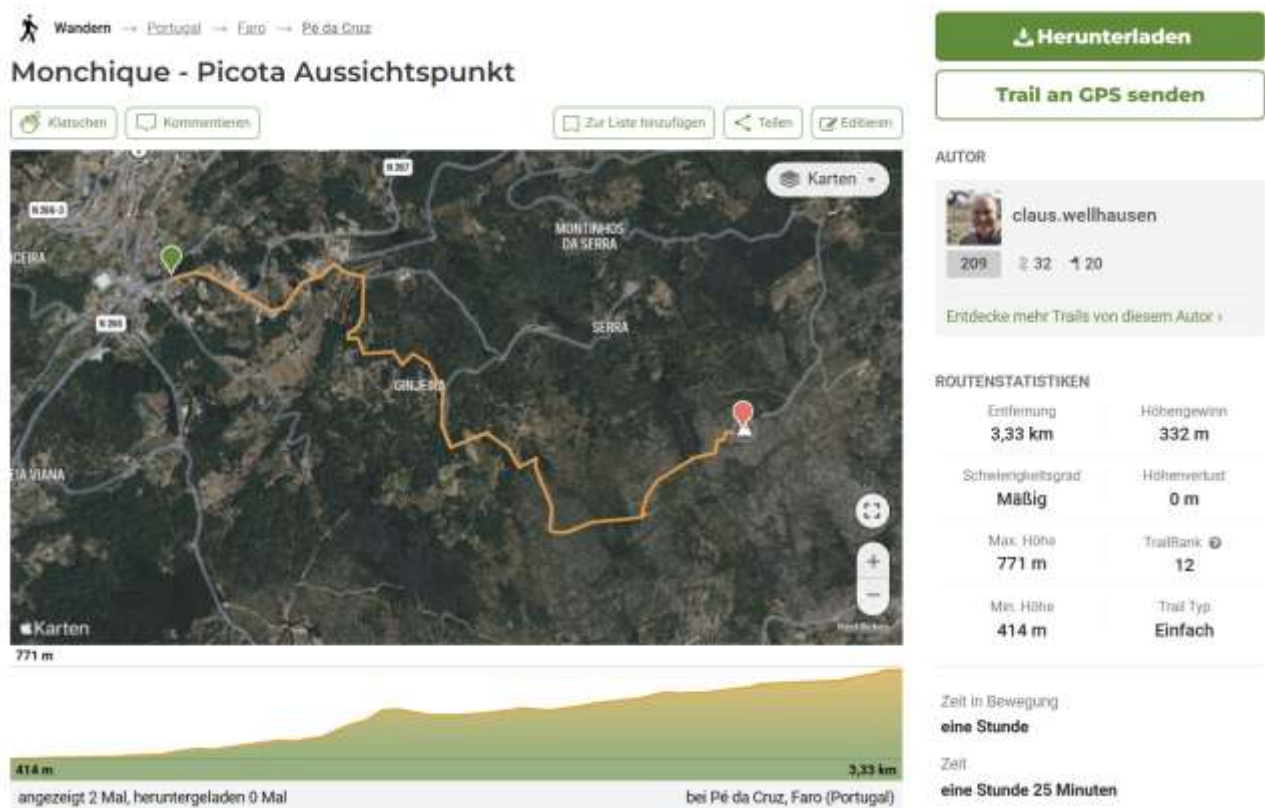

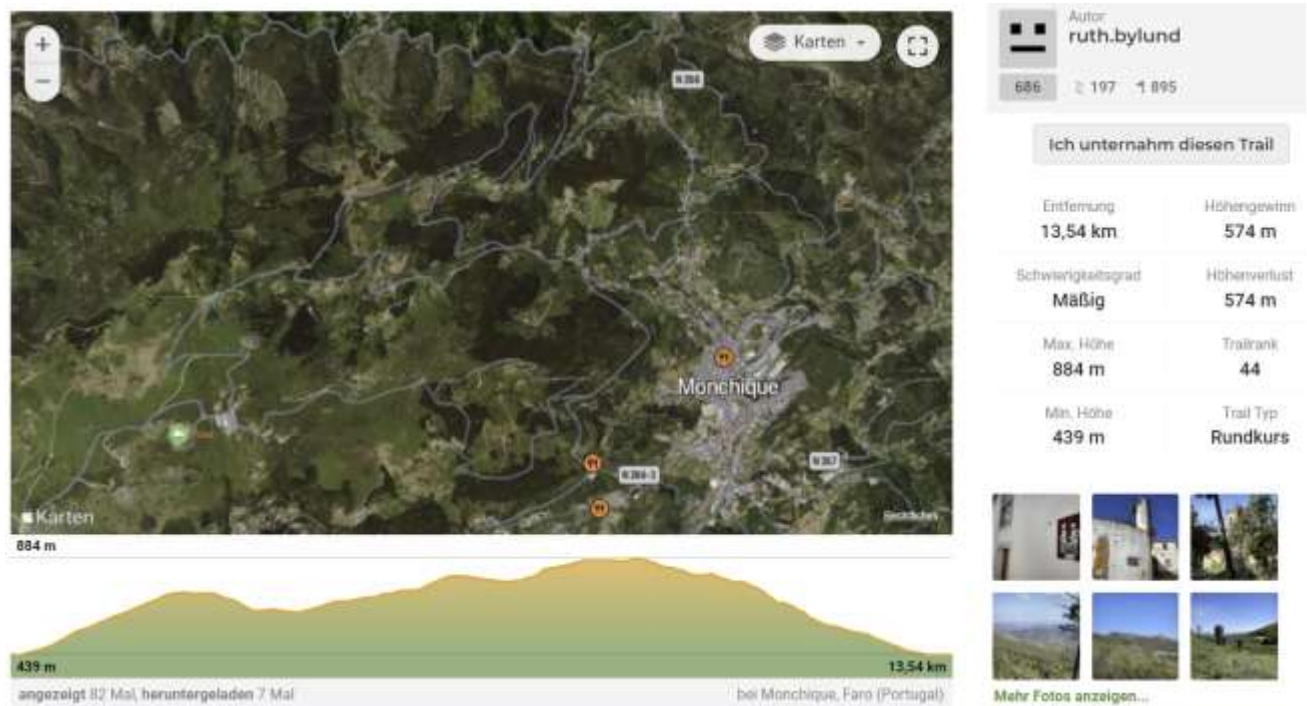

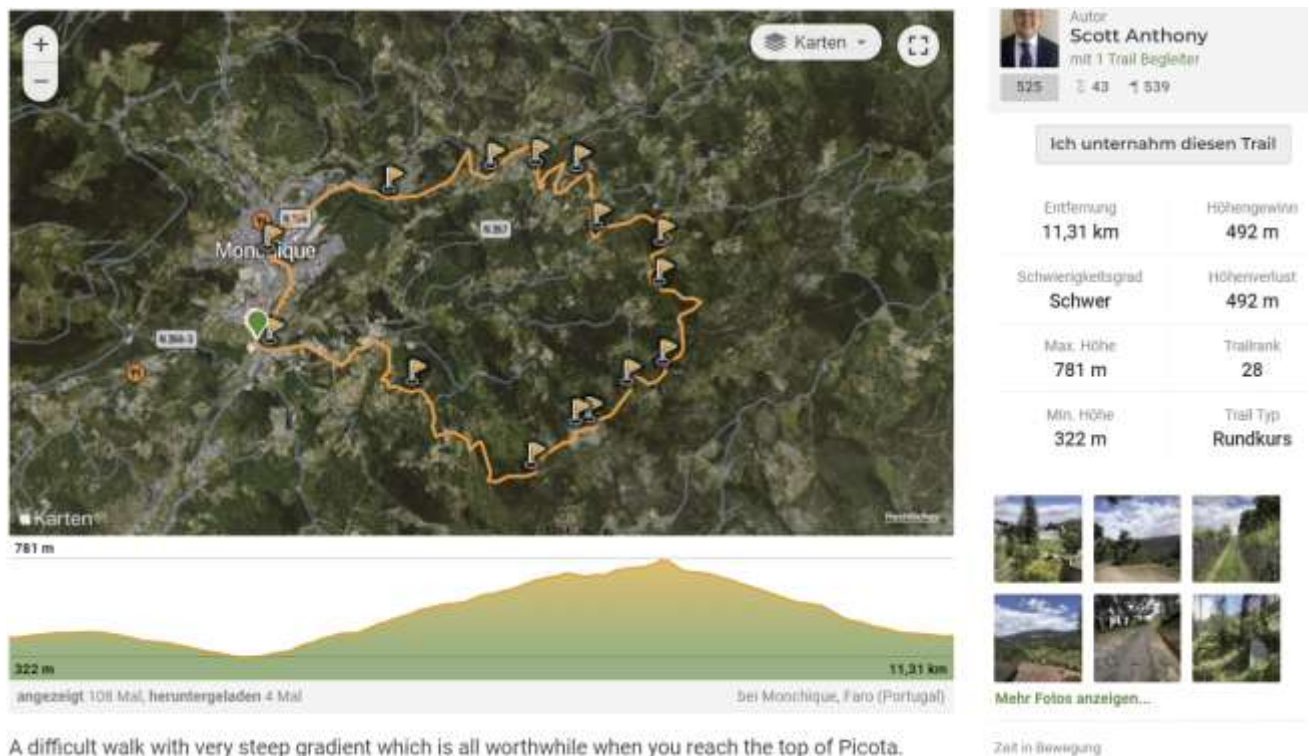

Walk through fertile vegetable gardens, in which corn, sweet potatoes and beans are grown, through fruit groves with oranges and lemons, with khaki and cherries as well as by extensive cork oak forests past chestnut trees, juniper bushes and strawberry trees that provide the raw material for the popular Medronho schnapps.

Description:

The 7.8 kilometer route "Pelos Caminhos de Alferce" leads around the village of Alferce. In part, it runs gently sloping through wonderful forests along the greek Monchique, later in the zigzag it goes uphill through agricultural areas, in places on a path, the paving of which still comes from the Middle Ages, partly past naked rock walls. Species, predatory and songbirds are feathered companions through nature.

Description:

Start in Alferce. Along the way, the geological structure of the Monchique Mountains can be easily traced along the route, characterized by deeply dug and richly vegetated river valleys and rugged hills. You are accompanied by the vocals of the book finches, titles and the meadows that nest in the magnificent cork oaks. A small detour leads up to the ruins of the Castelo de Alferce built by the Moors in the 9th century; From the nearby summit you can enjoy a stunning view.
